- Trees locations to be staked out a few weeks before.
- Motion to recommend RSI for tree bid made by Dulski, seconded by Wickline, approved.
- Hubert, L Wallace, and Vanhoose to be committee to examine and recommend design elements for nature play area.
- Next year's potential budget items. Remodel restrooms at Centennial, bike repair station, interpretive signage at posting station and around park describing, native plant areas, mountain biking path through wooded section of park, additional benches along existing walking trail, remove/mow stinging nettle
- Consider asking Swansea to deed over their section of the park,
