APPROVE MINUTES

- A. Trustee Miller made a motion to accept the Regular Board Meeting minutes for August 24, 2021 as presented. Trustee Isenhart seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Trustee Isenhart made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented for the month of August, 2021. Trustee Miller seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

BUDGET REPORT

Trustee Isenhart made a motion to approve the Budget Report as presented for the month of August, 2021. Trustee Miller seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

Approve Monthly Bills – Board List Trustee Greenfield made a motion to accept the bills as presented. Trustee Isenhart seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

ROAD COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Road Commissioner Trentman said that his crew has been mowing and oiling roads. He said that Hanks Excavating still has more work to do in the township. He has been moving the radar trailer around. Supervisor Korves said that we got the huge tree that fell in Centennial Park removed along with a couple others. We are still planning for the workday in Centennial Park on Oct. 16th and put a sign up at the park. She said there was a lot of emergency sewer work in September due to all the rain.

NEW BUSINESS

- A. Discussed and voted on playground equipment for kid's area in Centennial – We need to have it approved by NEPRD and installed prior to the next grant cycle so we can apply for another grant for a bridge to get to the other side of the creek. Trustee Buechler made a motion to approve. Trustee Isenhart seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.
- B. Discussed and voted on Bank of Belleville – Jackie Lemmon and Kevin Pesko did a proposal for us. They offered us a higher interest rate. We would like to make the change from Busey Bank to Bank of Belleville. Trustee Buechler made a motion to approve. Trustee Isenhart seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.
- C. Discussed and voted on appointing a FOIA Officer – Trustee Isenhart made a motion to approve Supervisor Korves. Trustee Miller seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.
- D. Discussed and voted on sewer plant locker room bid – We had 3 bids and went with Calhoun Construction. They were the lowest bidder, had a good reputation and we have also worked with them before. Trustee Buechler made a motion to accept Calhoun Construction and Supervisor Korves is authorized to execute any/all paperwork on the job. Trustee Greenfield seconded the motion. Voice vote. All were in favor except Trustee Miller. She abstained from voting because full details of the bids weren't available.
- E. Discussed and voted on new entrance sign for Centennial Park – Trustee Buechler made a motion to approve. Trustee Miller seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.
- F. Discussed and voted on new lawn mower for Parks Dept. – we had a 2005 lawn mower that wasn't working. Trustee Buechler made a motion to approve. Trustee Isenhart seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

- G. Discussed and voted on approving the audit by Scheffel, Boyle FY 2021 – We all received a copy of the audit. Trustee Isenhart made a motion to accept. Trustee Buechler seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

OLD BUSINESS

- A. Creek Bank Erosion – Supervisor Korves said we have 1 of the 2 permits in hand and will start when we get the second permit. We should have it within the next two weeks.
- B. Loop Creek Phase II Update – We finally have walls up and curbing. It is coming along well, but some things are back ordered due to Covid.
- C. CURES Grant – Thanks to Sue Gruberman and all her hard work, we received our check in the amount of 17,817.00.
