At 8:27 p.m. at the Regular Board Meeting, Trustee Barnes made a motion to go into closed Executive Session for purposes of considering litigation, and the Board finds that an action involving the Township is probable or imminent and for personnel issues. It was seconded by Trustee Schobert. Roll call vote. All in favor.

Supervisor Buchanan said that another proposal on the sewer negotiations was provided to Mayor Rauckman, and the Township thought it was exactly what the mayor wanted. Dave Thacker from Swansea told Supervisor Buchanan that the mayor wanted a bottom line number. Swansea at first wanted the Township to use Swansea's budgeted numbers for the proposal but now they want us to use numbers based on actual spending at the sewer plant to date. Supervisor said that we are waiting on Swansea to provide those actual spending numbers.

Margy Pearson asked if she could switch her work day from 7:30-4:00 to 8:00-4:30 so that she can spend more time in the morning with her son, who is having some difficulties in the mornings. This would continue until the end of the school year. The contract the Township has with the Union states the working hours are 7:30-4:00, so Supervisor Buchanan was told by the Township attorney that the Union will have to approve this as a special case and it will not be precedent setting. Supervisor Buchanan said it is a slight disadvantage to the Township but asked for the board's approval.

At 8:36 p.m. the Board returned to Regular Session.
