APPROVE MINUTES

- A. Trustee Buechler made a motion to accept the Regular Board Meeting minutes for July 27, 2021 as presented. Trustee Isenhart seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Trustee Isenhart made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented for the month of July, 2021. Trustee Buechler seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

BUDGET REPORT

Trustee Greenfield made a motion to approve the Budget Report as presented for the month of July, 2021. Trustee Buechler seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

Approve Monthly Bills – Board List Trustee Miller made a motion to accept the bills as presented. Trustee Isenhart seconded the motion. Voice vote. All in favor.

ROAD COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Road Commissioner Trentman said that his crew has been edging roads for September 21 oil date. They will be oiling roads out by Diane Dr. because they had run out of oil. He said they had been cleaning streets due to storms. They have also been doing concrete work in Chenot Place and Lincolnshire. The speed radar signs came this month so we can start putting them in different locations where there are speeding problems. Any questions please feel free to contact him at the township.

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT

Supervisor Korves said that we had a large tree come down in Centennial Park during the storm. The Centennial Park Fall cleanup has been set for Oct. 16 and she is getting together with the Park Board and do a walkthrough the park to identify what to cover on the cleanup day. The bathroom in the park is now open after some upgrades.

PUBLIC COMMENTS Tonda VanHoose said she likes the painted bathrooms in the park. Charles Wilbur pointed out that on the bike trail there are steel plates on the approaches over the bridges. He said that the one at Loop Creek by the park has a bump up that he is afraid he will blow out a tire on his bike.

NEW BUSINESS

- A. Sewer plant was hit by lightning during the storm and knocked out a BFI pump, so we ordered a new one and it is already installed.

OLD BUSINESS

- A. Creek Bank Erosion – Supervisor Korves said we have 1 of the 2 permits in hand and will start when we get the second permit.
- B. Centennial Signs – The stock signs will be ready for approval in 2 weeks. The custom signs will take about 6 to 8 weeks.
- C. Centennial Bathroom – it is painted. Hot and cold water working.
- D. Loop Creek Phase II Update – It is coming along pretty well, but some things are back ordered due to Covid.
- E. Locker Room – Bathroom at sewer plant is out for bid.
- F. MEPRD Grant – We got it. Agreement signed.
- G. CURES Grant – We got everything in. Just waiting for funds.
